Dear ladies and gentlemen,

it seems to me that Germany is beginning to play a dominant role in the European Union. I don't like this. Unfortunately there are some people outside of Germany who obviously like this and support this. They advocate for a leading role of Germany. I don't understand why.

At the present time Germany is economically strong. Our Chancellor, Mrs. Angela Merkel, has got a strong position in Germany. But nobody is perfect. Mrs. Merkel made two mistakes recently. She shouted out to the world: Please come to Germany everybody. This was not a good idea. And some days ago she said: We must talk also with Assad. I am happy that President Hollande and some German politicians reject this idea. Merkel has not very strong principles. It is impossible to make a deal with a mass murderer. Peter Struck (our former defence minister †) said: Mrs. Merkel is a good pilot but you never know where she will be landing.

Do we need a single person who leads Europe? Do we need a leader again, even a German leader? A leader who tells all the other European countries what they have to do and even what they have to think?

It is great that the European countries are somewhat united, united in a peaceful community. When I was young I was very much supporting the idea of a united Europe. But I don't want that Europe becomes another hegemon like the US, China und the Russian Federation. I don't like that one person in Europe should have the same power as the president of the United States of America.

It is often stated that Europe will be powerless if it can not speak with one voice. But is this really true? I believe in unity in diversity. The power and superiority of Europe is freedom. In my opinion Europe should be a union of free countries, countries which agree on some principles and issues, but are free to decide not to agree on other issues. Each country should be free to decide which immigrants are accepted and which are not. Each country should be allowed to keep its culture, its religion, its identity, or to change its identity, its character, its population. Of course some principles, e.g. the human rights, must be a common basis. Europe is not powerless as a union of free states. The states can always decide to fight together against an enemy, e.g. the IS.

I am very disappointed by the present European Union. The US send soldiers to the Ukraine – why don't we, the EU? The Kurds (this poor and maltreated people) have to fight against the IS – where are we Europeans? We sit in our armchairs and watch the cruelties and atrocities of the IS, unable to fight side by side with the Kurds and to eliminate the reincarnation of Satan radically. Our boys and girls stay conveniently at home.

Some Europeans are bombing the IS at least. But not so Germany. Germany also failed in Libya. Germany has aircrafts and helicopters which don't work and rifles which miss their target. Can this country be a leading nation? The big German company Volkswagen has produced the greatest cheating ever. Can this country be a leading nation?

But of course I am totally against something like a leading nation at all. If we have to defend Europe we can always come to an agreement and combine our efforts and facilities. But we must realize, that pacifism sometimes results in ruin. I am afraid that we have forgotten about history, e.g. the history of the Vandals and Rome. The Roman Empire, ten ti-

mes superior to the primitive barbarians, was so effete that it was unable to prevent the conquest of the city of Rome by the Vandals.

The EU commission in Brussels obviously likes to please Mrs. Merkel and endorses her unlimited acceptance of refugees. In my opinion the commission should have a more neutral attitude and also respect the opinions of other members of the EU. The commission and you, the governments, have made a great mistake in the last years. Since several years it is obvious that Italy and Greece are not able to deal with the masses of refugees that enter their countries. The EU should long ago have established reception facilities („hot spots“) in Italy and Greece or even in African countries in order to relieve these countries and to register the incoming people in a correct way and either to give them adequate accommodation or to send them home immediately.

The EU and the NATO have made the great mistake not to destroy the army of president Assad from the very beginning of the Syrian insurgency. At that time everybody (except me) argued that this would not be possible like in Libya because this would result in a great disaster. And Putin and China prevented the acceptance of a respective resolution of the security council. Would the disaster have been greater than it is now? Certainly not. And why listen to the two members of the security council, who are a mass murderer like Putin and a suppressor of peoples like China. What is the purpose for which the security council was established? Can its aim be achieved by considering these two countries? Millions of refugees, 250 000 of dead people and several 100 000 of tortured and mutilated men and women and children, this is the success of this kind of security council. The free world was able to destroy the great army of Hitler. It would have been less difficult to eliminate Assad. At least a no-fly zone could have been established.

The refugee crisis is a result of many mistakes of „the West“. One great reason is the policy of the hegemon US since many decades. One great mistake is that the Kurdish people was not given an own state. The Turks have expelled the Greeks, murdered the Armenians and are maltreating the Kurds since more than a century. The West, especially the US and Germany stick to the more powerful Turks at the cost of the poor and underdeveloped Kurds. This is a sin and we see the results of it in Turkey and in the region again and again. The world can only get better when we will get more honest and give equal rights to small and less developed peoples. Of course the person mainly responsible for the present Syrian catastrophe is Baschar al-Assad. He fought and is still fighting against his own people instead of protecting it against the IS.

I am a Christian and ready to help somebody who is in hardship. But first of all, thousands are coming to Europe now who are not seriously in hardship. Secondly there are other means to help the refugees. The Syrians and Iraqis are victims of the backwardness of the Islamic great world. So it is appropriate that they are received by their Islamic neighbour countries. There are extremely rich Islamic countries and Germany is also very rich. The neighbour countries should be supported financially by the Gulf states, by Germany, by the US and by the United

Nations. This is a better help than the translocation of people out of their culture into a different culture. I am against the mixing of people of different cultures, religions and races. The problems of countries with mixed populations can be seen in most countries all over the world. It doesn't make sense to increase these problems or to initiate them in countries in which they don't already exist.

I am an old German man, a Christian, like many others. Our German media are bombing us from morning to night with appeals and pleas to welcome the refugees, to be happy that they are coming. We are taught ten times a day that we urgently need immigrants. Critical opinions are not published. Obviously we don't have a free press any more in Germany. We hear every day that we Germans are enthusiastic about the refugees, that they are welcomed by our society, no matter how many thousands of them arrive. It is said that we Germans are the best people, the champions, and Angela Merkel is mother Theresa of the poor. The integration of a million this year and another million next year in Germany will be expensive, but Merkel says: „Wir schaffen das“ („we will achieve this“ or „we will manage it“ or just „we can“).

Many of us can no longer listen to this propaganda of Merkel and our journalists. Many say: I can't read the newspapers any more and I don't switch on the TV any more. Do we really need immigrants from the Islamic world and from Africa? What about the millions of unemployed young people in the south of our own Europe? I don't trust our media any more. Who needs immigration? Of course the bosses of the industry, the big shareholders, they need cheap labourers and masses of consumers. They grip the disaster as a chance to increase their profit. Our own unemployed people in Germany and our old-age pensioners don't need immigrants. They will suffer from inevitable tax increases. Merkel and all the journalists who are so enthusiastic about the flood of refugees will not. Merkel is a slave to the lobbyists of the big companies.

Some journalists admit that „there are people who are concerned and scared“. This may be true. But I and many others are not scared at all. We just want to keep our home country as our home country and our Europe with its great European nations and not transform it into a melting pot of cultures, religions, traditions and mentalities. Many German journalists are dreaming of a European melting pot. Not me!

Happy Switzerland! Switzerland is a really democratic country. The Swiss can still decide on what happens in their country. I would like that also the countries in the EU have the right to decide independently about issues which concern their national character and identity.

Photos don't lie. I guess that about 70 % of the people streaming into the EU are healthy young men, fit for military service. Why don't they go to the free Syrian army and fight against Assad and for a free and democratic Syria? They don't like to deal with a gun, they like mobiles. They are cowards, running away from their country and into the arms of Mrs. Merkel. Do we need this kind of men in Europe? It is not sure whether Putin will attack our

Eastern countries as he did on the Crimea and as he keeps doing in the Ukraine. These young men will be of no help.

I think it was on September 8th. I listened to an interview on the radio with the British historian and political scientist Anthony Glees. The interviewer seemed to be a bit puzzled as Mr. Glees was not excited by the German “Willkommenskultur” (culture of welcome) but said that many people in Britain are afraid that the character of Europe will be changed and that many Britons think that the Germans lost their brain. There are people in Germany who set fire to houses designated for the accommodation of refugees. These people are criminals. They are called “Rechtsextremisten” (right-wing extremists) and Nazis and “fremdenfeindlich” (xenophobic) by the media. And there are people like me who are neither right-wing nor Nazi nor xenophobic. But people like me who dare to express their opinion are automatically called right-wing extremists, Nazis and xenophobic. And they are automatically blamed for the criminal acts that the real right-wing extremists and criminals perform. This is crazy but it is the reality in my country. And this is the reason why no journalist dares to be even slightly less enthusiastic about the welcoming of refugees. The situation reminds me of the situation in the parliament of North Korea. None of the members there dares to applaud less enthusiastic than the others to Kim Jong-un. Sometimes I think there must be somebody behind the stage who pulls the strings of all the puppet-journalists. I don't know how this comes about. Perhaps the Britons are right: The Germans lost their brains.

Whenever fire is set to a refugee house there is an enormous hype about it. Why? It is a criminal act that should be investigated and prosecuted, that's it. But this is not the case. Day after day the media are upset and revile people like me who are just not excited about the avalanche of refugees but just dare to express their opinion.

Sometimes the “right-wing extremists” make a demonstration in a city. They don't do any harm, they just demonstrate their opinion in the streets. But as they are considered potential criminals the politicians promote anti-demonstrations. So demonstrators and anti-demonstrators meet in the streets and thousands of police men are necessary to keep them apart and can hardly avoid fights and injuries.

Politicians and journalists warn people to join a demonstrating group in which there might be some right-wing extremists. So did our chancellor and many other politicians. How then can people like me demonstrate their opinion? How should they recognise right-wing extremists and avoid that some of them join their demonstration?

Why do people set fire to houses? Certainly not because they suffer from pyromania. They want to express their political opinion that they don't like to have a lot of refugees from is-

lamic countries in their neighbourhood. But as the expression of this opinion is not possible in a normal democratic way and not respected but blasphemed and criminalised by our politicians those people see only one way of action, a criminal one. The politicians claim to promote democracy and tolerance, in fact they do the opposite.

Now the great liar Putin has his aircrafts in Syria. He wants to fight terrorism. It is fairly sure, that he defines terrorists like his friend and mass murderer Assad, namely everybody who is against Assad. When will the free world understand who Putin is? Are forgotten the wars in Chechenya, forgotten his tricks in the Crimea, forgotten his permanent lies in East Ukraine, forgotten the political murders in Moscow? Now in Syria is fighting not only Assad and Al Qaida and the IS and several other terrorist groups but also Putin. Great! The EU failed to act in time. Obviously it is euthanised by pacifism. The Roman empire perished because of the inclusion of masses of foreigners.

Dear Prime Ministers of Europe, dear President Hollande,

I would like to ask you to listen to your peoples and not to a newly rising European leader and then to decide which refugees and which immigrants and how many of them you allow to pass the borders of your countries. Take refugees as many as you find adequate, but don't accept instructions from anybody. Object to a European melting pot and help us to keep our wonderful European identity.
